It is very important to communicate with your child's teacher and discuss their progress. Please ensure you arrive promptly at your appointment time. Meetings will be


10 minutes in duration and we ask that parents knock on the classroom door at their appointment time for face-to-face meetings. Please be mindful not to delay, parents will be waiting as meeting times are scheduled back to back. If you require a longer meeting, an alternative meeting will have to be arranged at a later date. This will ensure that any concern can be discussed properly and without encroaching on another parent's allocated time.

Seesaw

Please ensure you have updated the Permission Section on Aladdin for the Digital Learning Platform Seesaw. We will be using Seesaw for many tasks over the coming months. Each pupil will build up their own individual digital portfolio. All classes will receive tasks/homework to complete on Seesaw each week.
