St. Brigid's N.S. is situated in an idyllic rural setting over the historic Hartley Bridge on the Grand Canal in Ticknevin, Carbury, Co. Kildare. Our school has served generations of our community since 1953.

Ethos: St. Brigid's N.S. is a Catholic school which welcomes pupils of all denominations and none.

Mission/Vision: Our mission is to provide each student with a diverse education in a safe, supportive environment that promotes self-discipline, motivation and excellence in learning. Facilities

Our classrooms are bright and spacious with interactive whiteboards in each room and access to a bank of laptops. We have a wide range of PE equipment, as well as access to a grass pitch facility. Our grounds are tree lined and expansive covering an area in excess of 4 acres, affording the opportunity to engage in numerous outdoor learning activities. Pupils attend swimming classes at the nearby pool in Edenderry.

Our large playground is marked with games and a **Buddy Bench** and we have a designated area for pupils requiring a quieter playspace in our **Sensory Garden**.

Our Sensory Room provides a quiet calm space.

Each classroom has access to a large selection of recommended and popular children's books in their libraries.

We operate a Book Rental Scheme for school books which parents find very cost effective


English and Drama: Aistear, Shared Reading, Reading Buddies, D.E.A.R. (Drop Everything and Read), Mobile Kildare Library.

Maths: Maths Trails, Numeracy station-teaching, Team-teaching for Numeracy, Maths Week Challenges, Mangahigh.


Music: Singing, Tin Whistle, Visiting Musicians, Drumming Workshop, Sean Nós Workshop.
